## Conflict Minerals Statement

At SIJ Metal Ravne, we follow the OECD (Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development) recommendations on due diligence for responsible supply chains of minerals from conflict and high-risk areas.

Suppliers are checked for their compliance with applicable laws and regulations regarding "conflict minerals"- 3TG metals (tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold) and cobalt. In addition, the supplier must put in place a management system to ensure that the tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold and cobalt contained in the products it manufactures or supplies are not used to finance or benefit, directly or indirectly, armed groups that commit serious violations of human rights. In addition, the Supplier complies in particular with Regulation 2017/821 on conflict minerals in Europe and Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act in the USA.
