Conformity with the requirements of End-of-Life Vehicle Regulation

The EU follows the concept of Extended Producer Responsibility for the automotive industry with Directive 2000/53/EC, the end-of-Life Vehicles (ELV) directive.

The directive targets recovery of waste arising from ELV and reduction and control of hazardous substances. Specifically, the use of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium should be restricted.

We hereby confirm that all products from SIJ Metal Ravne d.o.o. are compliant with the article 4.2 of Directive 2000/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 2000-09-08 on End-of-Life Vehicle and its Annex II.
